UNIFORM GUIDELINES

Uniforms are available from Ken Lane Menswear High Street at Maitland or Lowes at Maitland.

We encourage the children to take pride in their appearance and to dress in the correct uniform at all times. Here are a few practical ways you can help your children.

- Ensure that their uniform is always neat, clean and tidy
- School shoes are to be polished
- School hat to be worn at all times and is compulsory
- ALL CLOTHING CLEARLY LABELLED

A note explaining any variation in the school uniform is necessary and expected.

GROOMING & ACCESSORIES

ACCESSORIES

Students may wear:

- one small stud or one sleeper in each ear lobe (silver or gold)
- one signet ring
- one plain gold or silver 'golf' bangle
- one watch (Please see Personal Technology Device Policy in regard to the wearing of apple &/or android watches at school).

Please Note

Items worn by students that do not comply with school policy will be removed.

GROOMING

- Hair is to be the child's natural colour, worn off the face and tied back if it is long (in a style that allows the wearing of the school hat).
- Styles are expected to be reasonably conservative.
- Unacceptable styles include marked change from a natural hair colour, or extreme contrast in balayage or streaked hair.
- Other unacceptable hairstyles include radical hairstyles such as mullets, rat tails, dreadlocks, mohawks, extreme uneven grades, extreme undercuts, and patterns or designs shaved into the hair.
- Hair accessories must be in the school colours of navy or white in summer and navy or maroon in winter. Hairbands, scrunchies and ribbons must be plain or made out of school uniform fabric
- Make-up and nail polish (including shellac or gel) are not allowed

UNACCEPTABLE HAIRCUTS/STYLES FOR SCHOOL



GIRLS UNIFORM

SUMMER

Girls have a choice of wearing a blue/grey check tunic or blue peter pan collared blue shirt and dark blue shorts (2 styles available). White ankle socks, black leather school shoes and navy hair ribbons.

WINTER

Maroon/dark navy tartan pinafore or navy slacks. Sky blue peter pan collared long sleeve shirt, navy school jumper. Navy stockings with pinafore. Neck piece **ONLY** with slacks - NOT pinafore. Black leather school shoes. Navy or maroon hair ribbons. Navy embroidered school tracksuit jacket may be worn.

YEAR 5 AND 6 GIRLS (SENIOR) Pinafore minus the bib i.e., tartan skirt.

A tartan neck piece is worn with this.



BOYS UNIFORM

SUMMER

Blue short sleeve shirt, grey shorts, grey ankle socks and black leather school shoes.

WINTER

Blue long sleeve shirt, long grey pants, grey ankle socks, black leather school shoes, navy school jumper and maroon/black school tartan tie. Navy embroidered school tracksuit jacket may be worn.



SPORTS UNIFORM

Sports uniform is worn on an allocated day, parents will be informed by the class teacher which day your child is to wear Sport Uniform. uniforms

GIRLS

White polo shirt with embroidered school logo. Navy skort or navy microfiber short with

embroidered logo. White ankle socks and predominantly white joggers. (Bike shorts or fashion shorts are not acceptable).

BOYS

White polo shirt with embroidered school logo. Navy microfiber shorts with embroidered logo. White ankle socks and predominantly white joggers.

GIRLS & BOYS WINTER SPORT UNIFORM

Navy microfiber tracksuit jacket with embroidered school logo and matching microfiber tracksuit pants. White polo shirt with embroidered school logo. White ankle socks and predominantly white joggers. (Navy leggings or tights are NOT acceptable).



ACCEPTABLE BLACK SCHOOL SHOES

Shoes must be Black leather or leather look, as below.







NOT ACCEPTABLE BLACK SHOES

The following shoes are not acceptable as school shoes (joggers, skate shoes, canvas top etc)



THE UNIFORM POOL

WHAT IF MY CHILD IS NOT IN THE CORRECT UNIFORM?

We understand at times, that students may not be able to wear their full uniform. Please see below if this occurs.

- If your child is unable to wear the correct uniform, please let the school know either through emailing the front office or a handwritten note.
- If students are not wearing the correct uniform, they will be verbally reminded about expectations of uniform. Students will be given a week to ensure that they are able to access the correct uniform.
- If students continue to wear incorrect uniform, an email through Compass will be sent home to parents by the class teacher identifying the uniform needing to be corrected.
- Once this email is sent home and time has been given for the correct uniform to be sought (one week), if the incorrect uniform is still being worn, parents and students will be asked to meet with a member of the Leadership team to discuss school uniform expectations.
